

TRADITIONAL DRY BLASTING

The Ashrose Group specialise in using a low pressure damp sand jetting system that has been used nationwide for property restoration, including gaining approval for and subsequently working on many Listed Buildings.

The system, in our trained hands, causes minimal damage to an underlying surface and is flexible enough to tackle most property restoration cleaning tasks.

- Some jobs however, particularly inside buildings, the damp nature of our standard blast means that it can be a messy process - and a traditional dry sandblast can be of benefit - we use considerably more abrasive - but that abrasive is slightly more handleable.
- After a site inspection we might propose dry blasting instead, however the process is a lot more dusty (see the middle picture above), it is very unlikely we will recommend dry blasting outside - as much as anything because the abrasive and equipment must be kept dry - and UK weather doesn't always lend itself to this!
- We also have a blasting booth on our premises in Beverley where we can clean metalwork such as radiators, fireplaces, and some more bizarre items of dirty industrial equipment.
