While we specialise in using a low pressure damp sand jetting system there are some jobs where the more traditional approach of dry blasting has benefits that outweigh the downsides. For internal work, the damp nature of the blast does mean that the grime and spent abrasive sticks to surfaces, dry blasting, although it uses much much more abrasive, the debris isn't sticky. Sometimes therefore, we do recommend this more traditional approach, while keeping an eye on wood preservation.
